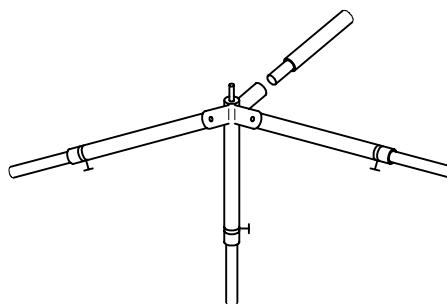


Figure A.30 — Adjustable poles

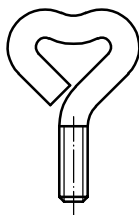


Figure A.36 — Wing screw

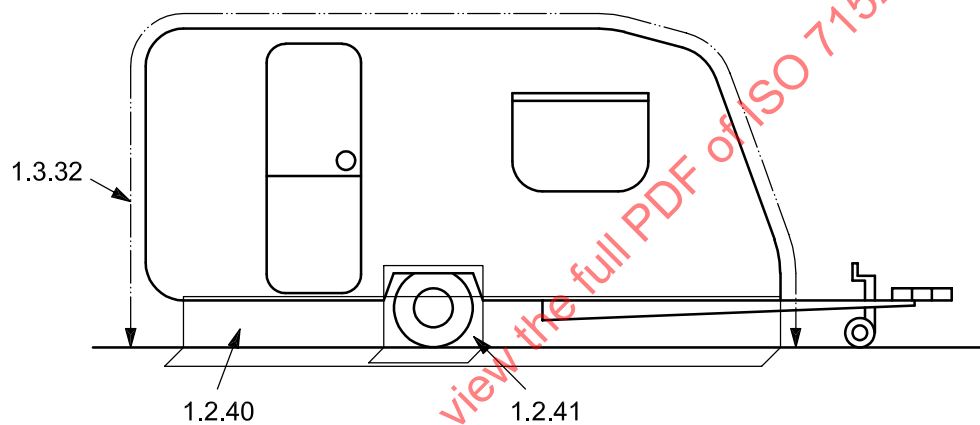


Figure A.58 — Perimeter
